## **Ninth Circuit to Reschedule Oral Arguments of High-Profile Cases in Las Vegas and Cancels UNLV Sitting**

SAN FRANCISCO – Due to concerns over community spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019, or COVID-19, two high-profile cases on calendar for March 23, 2019, at the Lloyd D. George United States Courthouse in Las Vegas will be rescheduled at a later date and location to be determined. The special sitting on March 24 at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, William S. Boyd School of Law, also has been cancelled. Below are the two high-profile cases to be rescheduled:

- USA v. Cliven Bundy, et al, Case 18-10287
- USA v. Todd Engel, Case 18-10293

Following the guidance provided by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, the Ninth Circuit has been following all recommendations promoted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The court will continue to assess the situation. Please check the court's website at <https://www.ca9.uscourts.gov/> for announcements about any changes to hearings or sittings in other locations. The court will directly notify the parties about any such changes.

The Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals hears appeals of cases decided by executive branch agencies and federal trial courts in nine western states and two Pacific Island jurisdictions. The court normally meets monthly in Seattle, San Francisco, and Pasadena, California; every other month in Portland, Oregon; three times per year in Honolulu; and twice a year in Anchorage, Alaska.
