1. 12-35450, Briefing Schedule: The opening brief and any request for relief is due Sunday June 3, 2012 by 6 pm Pacific Time (PT). The answering brief is due Monday June 4, 2012 by 6 pm PT. The reply brief is due Tuesday June 5, 2012 by 6 pm PT. The Court has read all filings in the district court so the parties are encouraged to file abbreviated briefs, focused upon the correctness of the district court's June 1, 2012 order.

2. 12-35427, Briefing Schedule: The briefing schedule set May 29, 2012 remains in effect. The answering brief is due Saturday June 2, 2012 by 5 pm PT. The reply brief is due Sunday June 3, 2012 by 5 pm PT.

3. Any Appeal from First Amendment Case, Dist. Ct. No. 12-cv-255: Once the district court rules and a party files a notice of appeal, the Court will set an expedited briefing schedule. The Court will have read all filings in the district court so the parties will be encouraged to file abbreviated briefs, focused upon the correctness of the district court's order.

4. Oral Arguments in 12-35450 and 12-35427 and Any Appeal from First Amendment Case, Dist. Ct. No. 12-cv-255: Oral arguments for all 3 cases are set for Thursday June 7, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. PT (10:30 a.m. Mountain Time) at the Richard H. Chambers Courthouse, 125 S. Grand Avenue, Pasadena, CA 91105. Counsel may appear in person in Pasadena, CA or may appear via videoconference. A videoconference link will be available at the U.S. District Court, 550 W. Fort Street, Boise, Idaho 83724. The Clerk's Office for the Ninth Circuit will be in contact with the parties regarding room locations.
