ORDER

Appellants' request to file the oversized emergency motion for injunctive relief is granted. The oversized motion has been filed.

Appellants' emergency motion for injunctive relief pending appeal is granted. The court enjoins enforcement of the provisions of Arizona House Bill 2036 that place restrictions upon and criminalize the performance of abortions from 20 weeks gestational age, pending appeal. 2012 Ariz. Legis. Serv. 250 (H.B. 2036) (West) (to be codified as Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 36-2159); *see Winter v. Natural Res. Def. Council, Inc.*, 555 U.S. 7 (2008).
