


CERTIFICATION REQUIRED BY RULE

I, Joseph R. Wood, hereby state:

1. My attorney has advised me that *Rule 32.5* of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure states, in part, that "The defendant shall include every ground known to him or her for vacating, reducing, correcting or otherwise changing all judgments or sentences imposed upon him or her, and certify that he or she has done so."
2. I have been incarcerated continuously since August 7, 1989, and have had no opportunity to conduct any investigation on my own. I have relied on my lawyers and their associates, investigators, and others working for them for information about my case, and specification about what issues to consider. I have instructed them to raise all state and federal constitutional and other issues applicable to my case.
3. I am not a lawyer, I do not have a college degree. I have relied on my lawyers to advise me of all legal and mitigation-related grounds known to them for vacating, reducing, correcting or otherwise changing all judgments or sentences imposed upon me.
4. My lawyers have reviewed with me the issues they are raising in the petition for post conviction relief. Based upon my conversations with them, and in reliance on their advice regarding what grounds are presently available, I certify that the petition contains all known grounds for relief as made known to me by my lawyers at the present time and based on the present state of the law.
