ORDER

On July 2, 2014, Plaintiff Joseph Rudolph Wood III filed a Motion for Preliminary Injunction or Temporary Restraining Order requiring Defendants to disclose certain information about the drugs, drug protocol, and personnel that will be involved in his execution, which is set for July 23, 2014. (Doc. 11.) In a civil rights complaint filed June 26, 2014, Wood and plaintiffs Graham S. Henry, David Gulbrandson, Todd Smith, Charles M. Hedlund, and Eldon Schurz allege a violation of their First Amendment right of access to governmental information. (Doc. 1, ¶¶ 150-52.)

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Because Wood’s execution is scheduled to take place on July 23, 2014, the Court finds good cause to order expedited briefing and oral argument on his motion.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants shall file a response to Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction or Temporary Restraining Order no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 7, 2014. Plaintiff may file a reply no later than 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 8, 2014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument on Plaintiff’s motion will be held on Wednesday, July 9, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 504, 401 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2151.
