ORDER

The appellants' opposed motion to stay appellate proceedings pending the Supreme Court decision in *DeBoer v. Snyder*, Supreme Court Docket No. 14-571, is granted. Appellate proceedings are stayed until 14 days after the decision issues in *DeBoer* or June 30, 2015, whichever occurs first.

At or prior to the expiration of the stay of appellate proceedings, the appellants shall file the opening brief or file a motion for appropriate relief.

If the opening brief is filed, the answering brief will be due July 30, 2015. The optional reply brief is due within 14 days after service of the answering brief.

In the absence of a motion, the stay of appellate proceedings will terminate without further notice.
