The parties' April 21, 2016 letter is construed in part as a motion to sever case No. 15-17475 from consolidated case Nos. 15-17420 and 15-17422 and to stay appellate proceedings in 15-17420 and 15-17422 pending settlement negotiations. So construed, the motion is granted. However, the parties are reminded that requests for relief from this court should be made in the form of a motion. Fed. R. App. P. 27(a)(1).

Case Nos. 15-17420 and 15-17422 are stayed until June 3, 2016. At or prior to the expiration of the stay, the appellees shall file the answering briefs or a status report and motion for appropriate relief. If the answering briefs are filed, the optional reply brief will be due 14 days after service of the latter-served answering

brief. The filing of the answering brief or the failure to file a further motion will terminate the stay.

Case No. 15-17475 is severed from consolidated case Nos. 15-17420 and 15-17422. The answering brief for case No. 15-17475 remains due May 2, 2016. The optional reply brief is due within 14 days after service of the answering brief.
