ORDER

The parties are ordered to submit supplemental briefs as to whether the completed election makes this preliminary injunction appeal moot and, if not, what relief is available. The parties shall also address whether the en banc court should stay proceedings pending the entry of judgment by the district court on the request for permanent injunctive relief.

The briefs are not to exceed 7,000 words and are to be filed simultaneously within 14 days of the filing date of this order. Parties who are registered for ECF must file the supplemental brief electronically without submission of paper copies. Parties who are not registered ECF filers must file the original supplemental brief plus 11 paper copies.
