ORDER

Before: CLIFTON, N.R. SMITH, and FRIEDLAND, Circuit Judges.

The court has received the parties' joint proposed schedule for filings concerning appellants' emergency stay motion.

Any amicus filings supporting the emergency stay motion are due by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Monday, June 10, 2019.

Appellees' opposition to the emergency stay motion and any amicus filings opposing the emergency stay motion are due by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Tuesday, June 11, 2019.

The plaintiffs in case No. 4:19-cv-00872-HSG pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California (the "State Plaintiffs") may submit an amicus filing of up to 4,200 words opposing the emergency stay motion.

Any other amici may submit filings of up to 3,500 words regarding the emergency stay motion.

Appellants' request for leave to file a reply of up to 3,500 words in support of the emergency stay motion is granted. The reply is due by 2:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Friday, June 14, 2019.

The court will hold oral argument on the emergency stay motion at 2:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Thursday, June 20, 2019, in San Francisco, California.

Appellants will be allotted 20 minutes of argument time. Appellees will be allotted 20 minutes of argument time. The State Plaintiffs' request to participate in oral argument is granted. The State Plaintiffs will be allotted 10 minutes of argument time. Appellants will be allotted an additional 10 minutes of rebuttal time.
