Data

Metropolitan and micropolitan statistical areas (metro and micro areas) are geographic entities delineated by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for use by Federal statistical agencies in collecting, tabulating, and publishing Federal statistics. The term "Core Based Statistical Vicea" (CBSA) is a collective term for both metro and micro areas. A metro area contained core urban area of 50,000 or more population, and a micro area contains an urbancolor at least 10,000 (but less than 50,000) population. Each metro or micro are a following that of one of the counties and includes the counties containing the core urban a well as any adjacent counties that have a high degree of social and economic integration (as measpreadby commuting to work) with the chived on urban core.
