Arizona State Prison

- Double execution chair used in the gas chamber of Arizona State Prison when two brothers were executed in 1934.

Saguaro Cactus Furniture

- R. O. Perry designed and constructed furniture out of saguaro cactus at his workshop in Phoenix, Arizona during the late 1930's and 1940's.





Victorian Eastlake Parlor

- This parlor suite was styled by Englishman Charles Eastlake. Although living in dusty adobe homes of Florence, pioneers liked to furnish their homes as they did in the East.
