Randy had his hands in all kinds of work activities. He started out selling cars and then had a short stint counseling before teaching in Houston for two years.

Randy then got in the Home Health Care business for seven years in Reno and Las Vegas prior to spending his last three years in Las Vegas surveying for home construction. Randy then moved home to Montana — which was always where his heart was — and found work with A.W.A.R.E. He finished his working career driving truck on construction sites.

Randy is survived by his parents Jim and Barbara Street; sister Jackie Street McKenna; brother Jason Street; daughter Lexus Murphy; nieces Brittany, Brooke and Codi Jean; along with special friend, Amie Beckman and numerous cousins and other family members.
