Hamid Javadi and Mojgan Fooroughi, natives of Iran and citizens of Iran and Germany, and Armin Javadi and Zara Eileen Javadi, natives and citizens of Germany, petition for review of the Board of Immigration Appeals’ (“BIA”) order denying their motion to reopen removal proceedings and reissue its previous
