**ORDER**

**THOMAS**, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, alleges that a district judge improperly affixed an electronic signature to his orders in complainant's civil case, or that someone forged the judge's signatures. The only evidence complainant provides to support this allegation is that the signatures on two orders are identical. It is not improper for a judge to use an electronic signature stamp. This claim is dismissed as there is no evidence that misconduct occurred. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

**DISMISSED.**
