**ORDER**

**THOMAS**, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se litigant, alleges that a district judge improperly imposed excessive filing requirements. The allegation relates directly to the judge's case management decisions and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Complainant further alleges that the judge should recuse from his case due to a conflict of interest. Complainant filed a motion to recuse in the underlying case concurrently with this judicial misconduct complaint. Shortly thereafter, the judge recused, and the case has been reassigned. Thus the allegation is dismissed as moot. 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2).
