**ORDER**

**THOMAS**, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, filed a complaint against two circuit judges, however his submission raises no allegations of misconduct on the part of either judge. A judicial misconduct complaint “must contain a concise statement that details the specific facts on which the claim of misconduct or disability is based.” See Judicial-Conduct Rule 6(b). Further, the complainant must “set forth the alleged misconduct in a clear and straightforward fashion.” In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 630 F.3d 968, 968–69 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2010). Because complainant alleges no misconduct, the complaint is dismissed.

**DISMISSED.**
