ORDER**REINHARDT**, Circuit Judge¹:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, alleges that a circuit judge has “protected court fraud for the lower court” and has “performed a criminal act” in order to protect the alleged court fraud. These vague allegations are unsupported by any evidence or specific statements of fact, and are dismissed as unfounded. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 569 F.3d 1093 (9th Cir. 2009) (“claimant’s vague insinuations do not provide the kind of objectively verifiable proof that we require”); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

Complainant has previously raised similar, unsupported allegations against a district judge of this circuit. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, No. 15-90006. Complainant is cautioned that a “complainant who has filed repetitive, harassing, or frivolous complaints, or has otherwise abused the complaint

procedure, may be restricted from filing further complaints.” Judicial-Conduct Rule 10(a); see also In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 552 F.3d 1146, 1148 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009).
