ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, alleges that three district judges and two magistrate judges failed to correct constitutional violations related to his 1980 plea and sentencing in state court, and made improper rulings with regard to complainant's "three strikes" status under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judges' rulings and are therefore dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

DISMISSED.
