THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se litigant, alleges that a district judge was biased against him, treated him poorly, and made improper rulings. Complainant raised similar allegations in a previous complaint, and the charges were dismissed as unfounded and merits-related. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct No. 16-90174 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2016). Therefore, no further action is necessary. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(C); In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 563 F.3d 853, 854 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009).

DISMISSED.
