ORDER

Pursuant to Article VI of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a petition for review of the order of the Chief Judge entered April 2, 2026, dismissing the complaint against four district judges, eight circuit judges, and one magistrate judge of this circuit. Complainant has also filed a request to transfer his complaints to a different circuit.

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in her order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the order of dismissal.

For the reasons stated by the Chief Judge and based upon the controlling authority cited in support thereof, we affirm.

Further, we conclude there are no exceptional circumstances to justify complainant's transfer request, which is denied. *See* Judicial-Conduct Rule 26 and Commentary on Rule 26.
