Supplemental Administrative Order

Although Congress did not enact a funding measure by midnight on September 30, 2025, the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit will continue to carry out its constitutional duties.

Court Operations

- The Court will continue to accept new cases, process filings, decide motions, hear arguments as scheduled, and issue decisions.
- Cases set for hearing will go forward unless directed otherwise by the assigned panel.
- Government and CJA funded attorneys are directed to appear as scheduled.

Deadlines

- Timeframes for filing notices of appeal and petitions are unchanged. *See* FRAP 26(b).
- If you are a federal or CJA-funded attorney with a deadline during the shutdown (excluding oral argument scheduling), your filing deadline is stayed, and your due date will be reset by further order of the Court.
- All non-federal government attorneys and pro se litigants must continue to meet filing deadlines under the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and the Court's Local Rules: i.e., a Petitioner's opening brief deadline in an immigration case remains unchanged.

Court Discretion

- The Court may issue specific instructions in individual cases as needed.
