- 7) NARROW THE FOCUS
- 8) KNOW THE CASES CITED AND THE JUDGES WHO WROTE THEM
- 9) DON'T BE AFRAID TO BE DIFFERENT
- 10) AT ORAL ARGUMENT -- DISCUSS, DON'T DEBATE
