The parties and prospective intervenor shall appear by video for oral argument on the pending emergency motions to stay the district court's October 5, 2020 order and the State of Arizona's pending emergency motion to intervene, on Monday, October 12, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time. Further instructions will be provided to the appearing parties. The argument will be live-streamed and shall

take place in Courtroom 1 in San Francisco. Only one attorney for each party or prospective party shall be permitted to argue. Appellants Republican National Committee and National Republican Senatorial Committee will be allotted 15 total minutes of argument time. Prospective intervenor will be allotted 15 minutes of argument time. Appellees will be allotted 30 total minutes of argument time.

In addition to the merits of the emergency stay motions, the parties and prospective intervenor shall be prepared to address appellants' standing to bring this appeal and the State of Arizona's ability to intervene.
