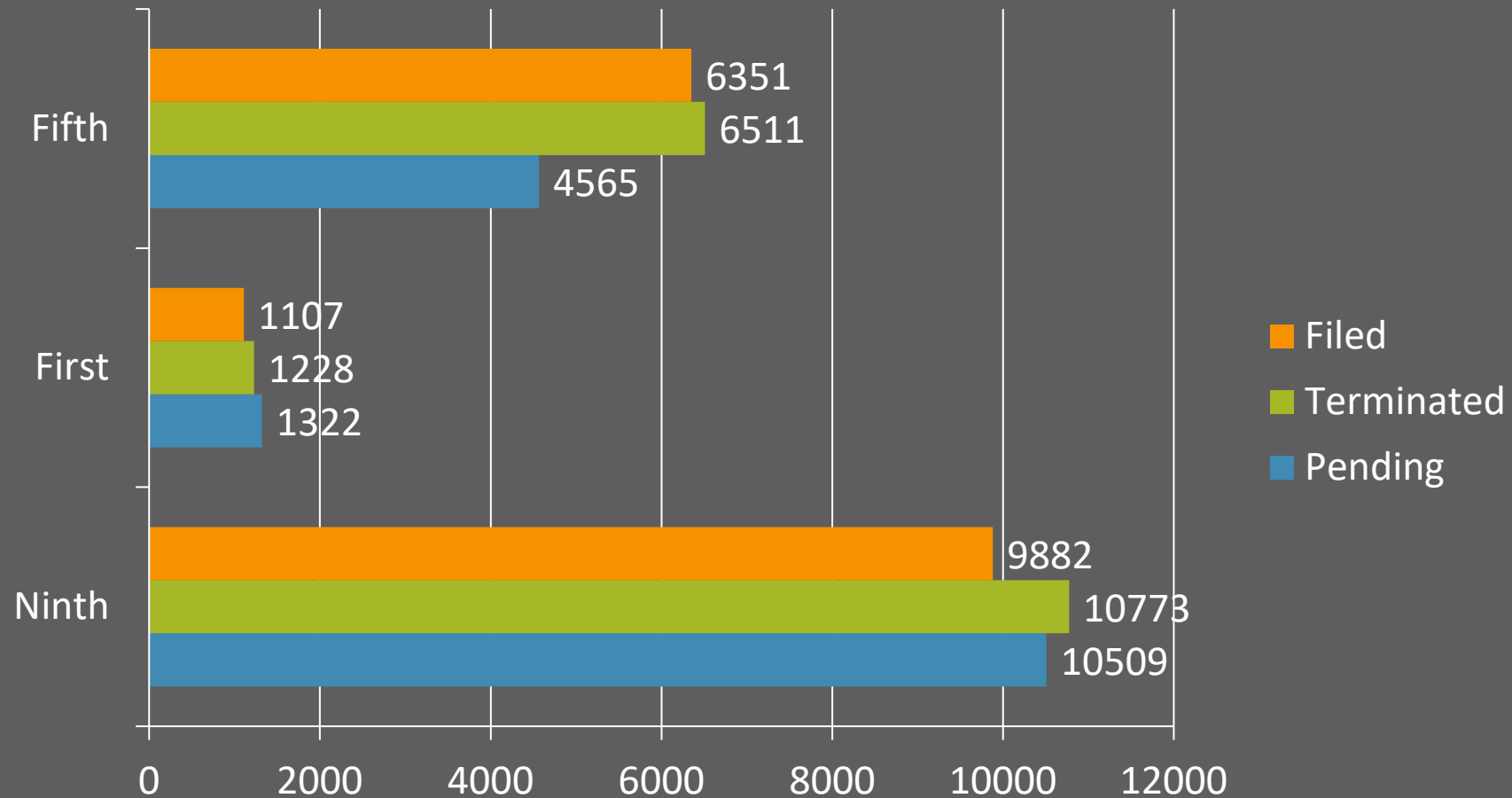

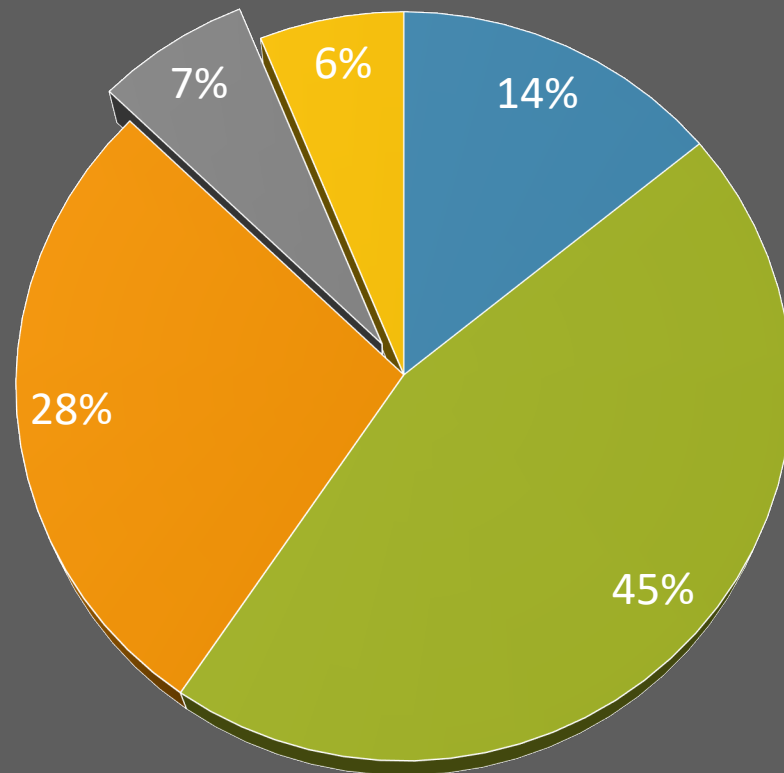

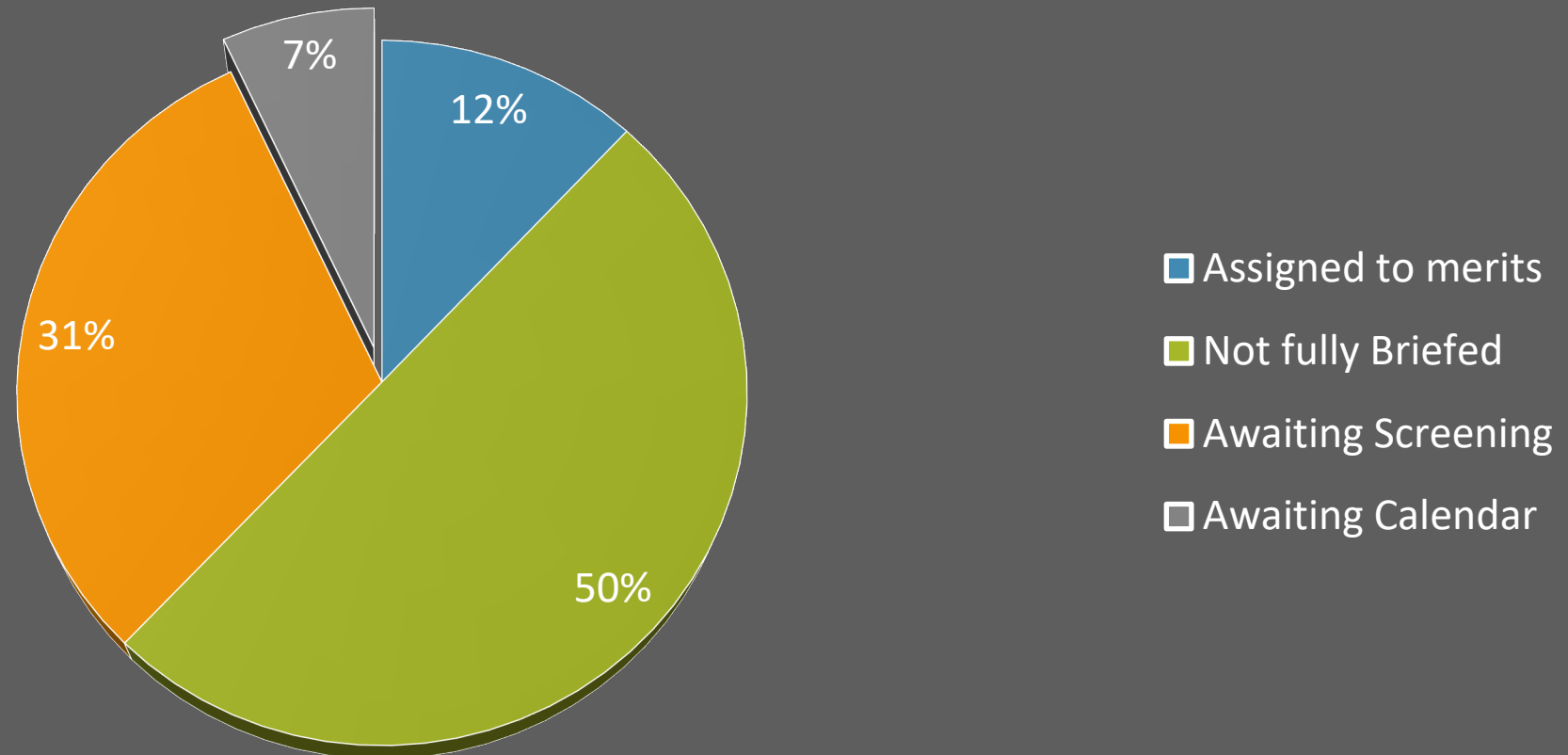

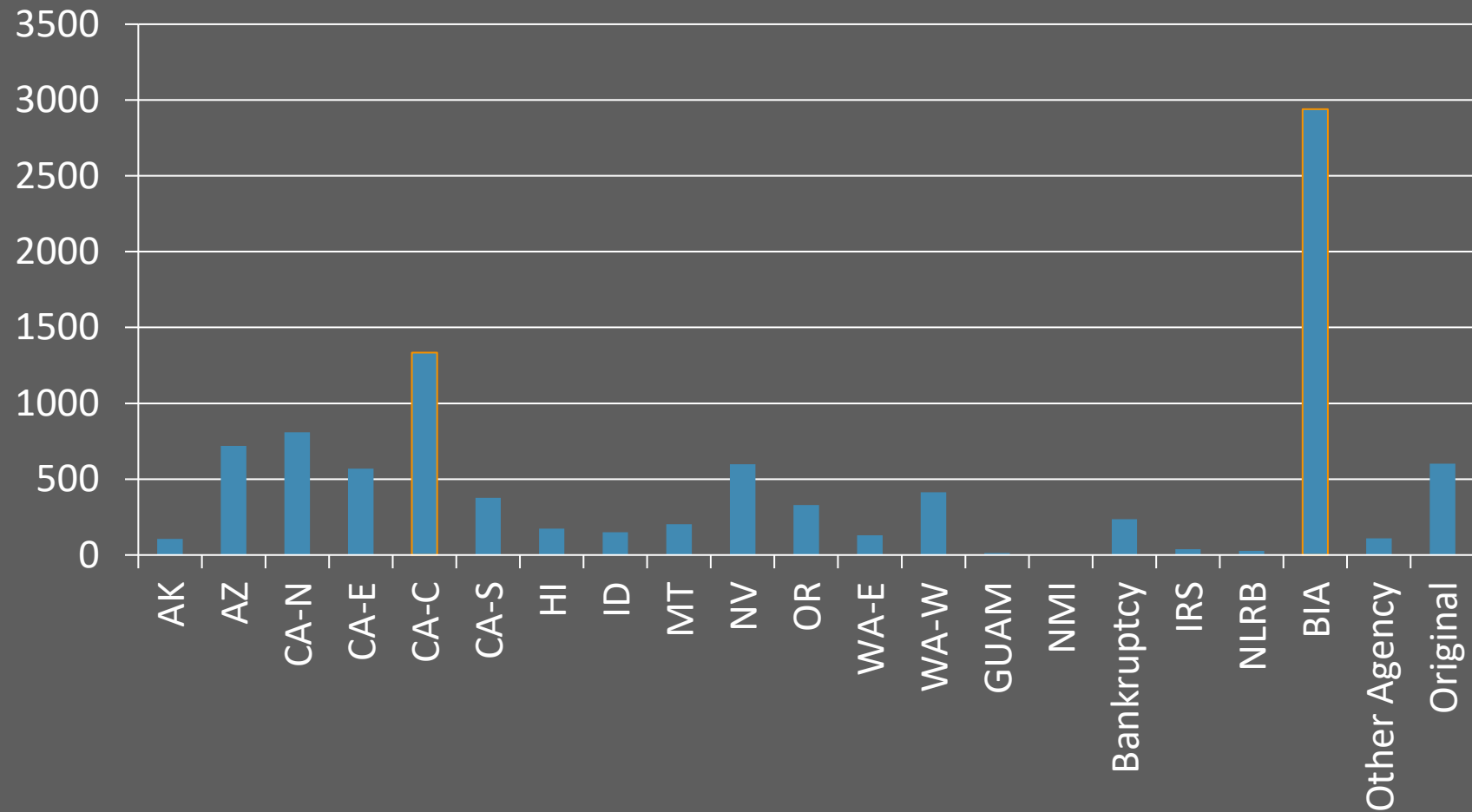

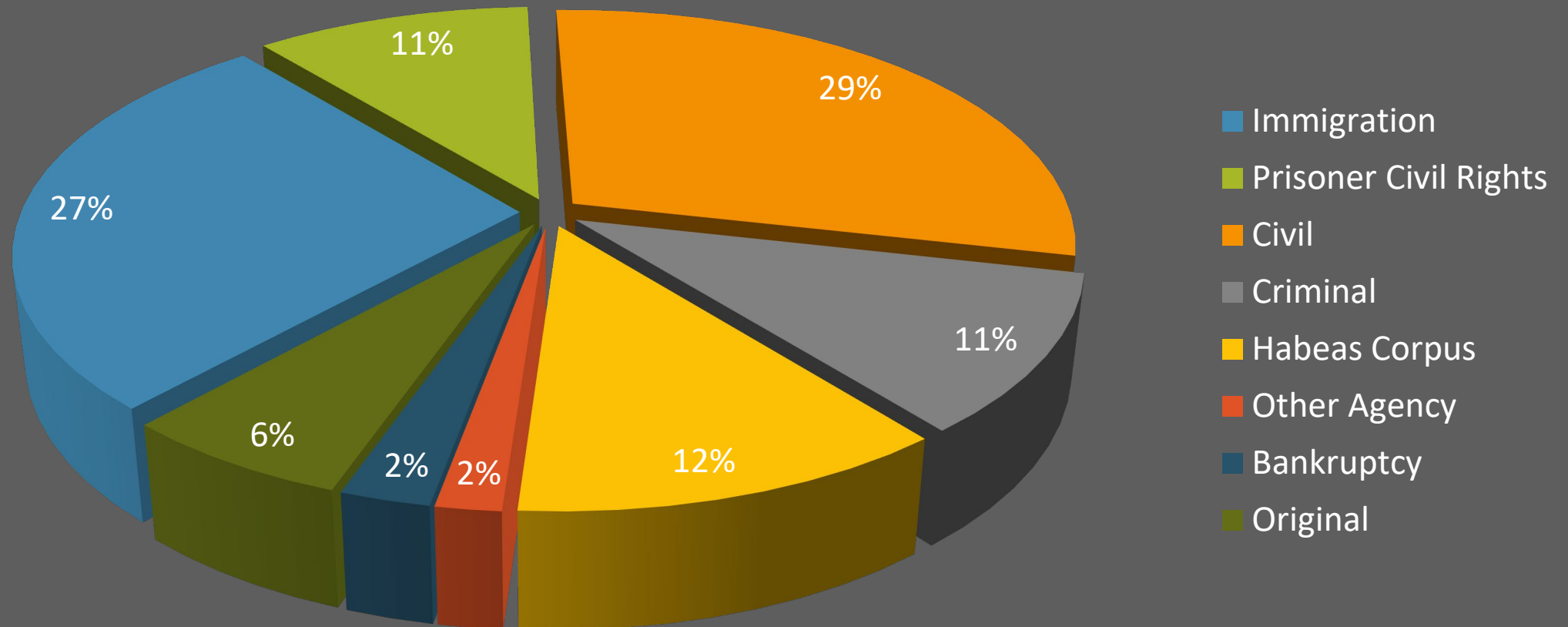

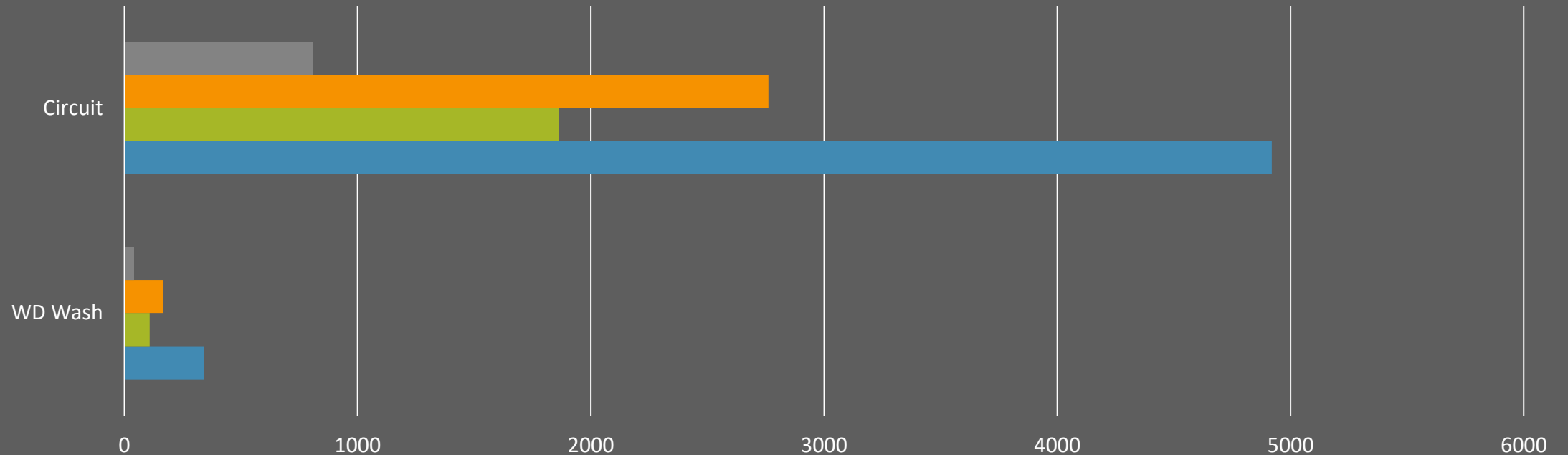


NEW FILINGS BY CASE TYPE

AGE OF PENDING CASES (CIRCUIT WIDE AND WD WASH)

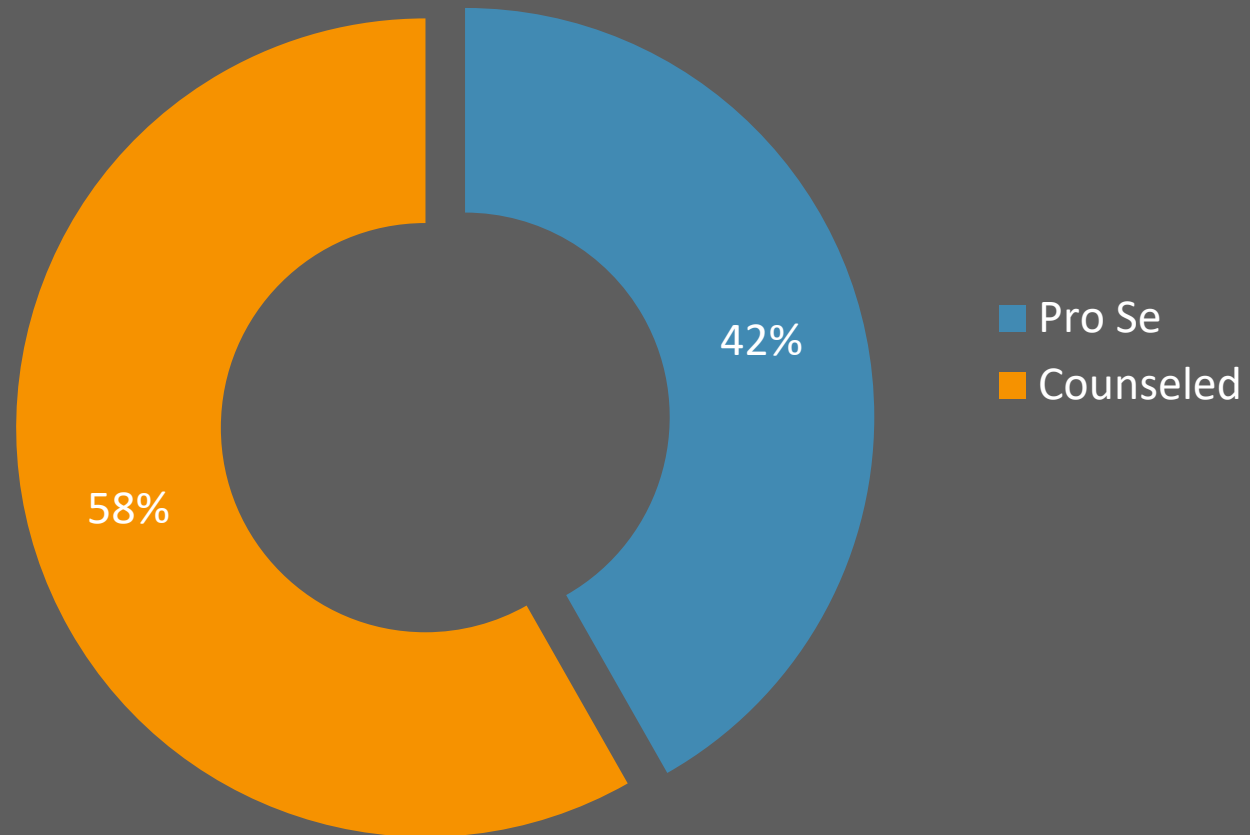

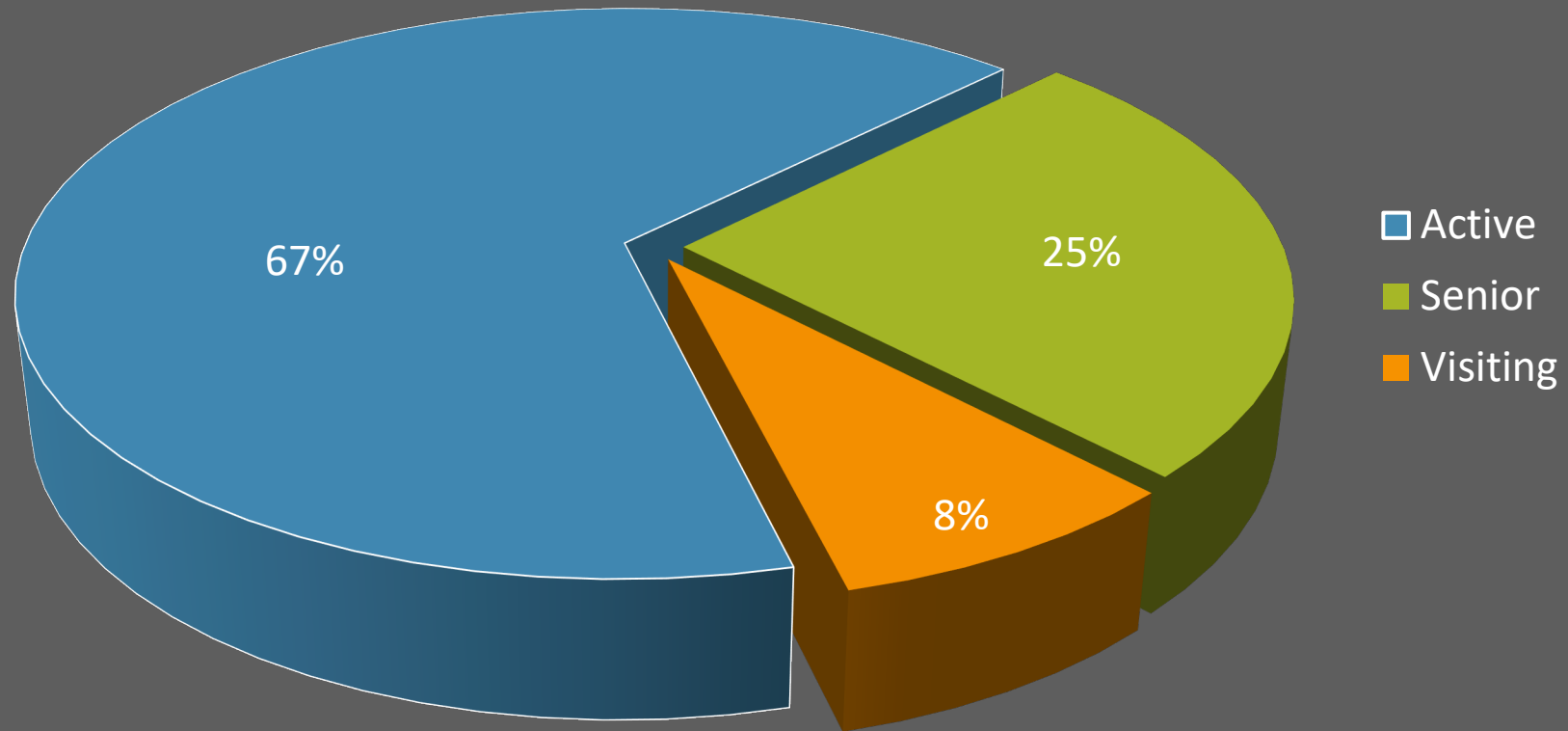

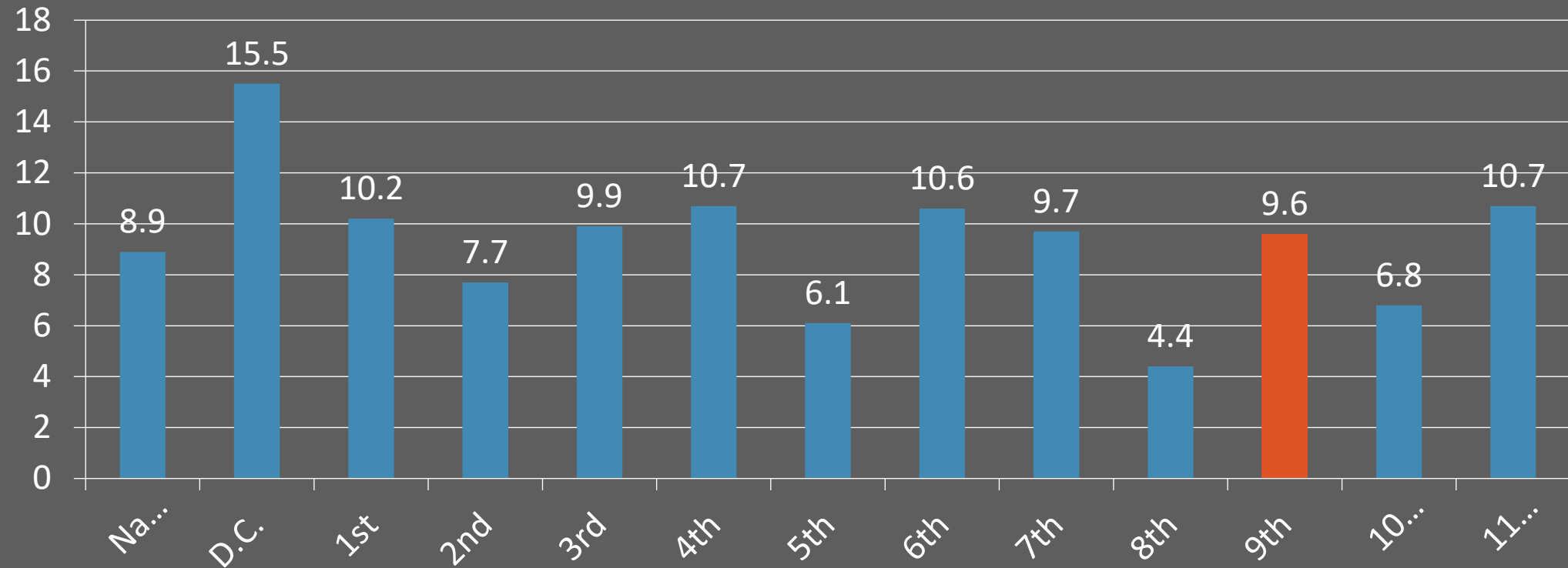

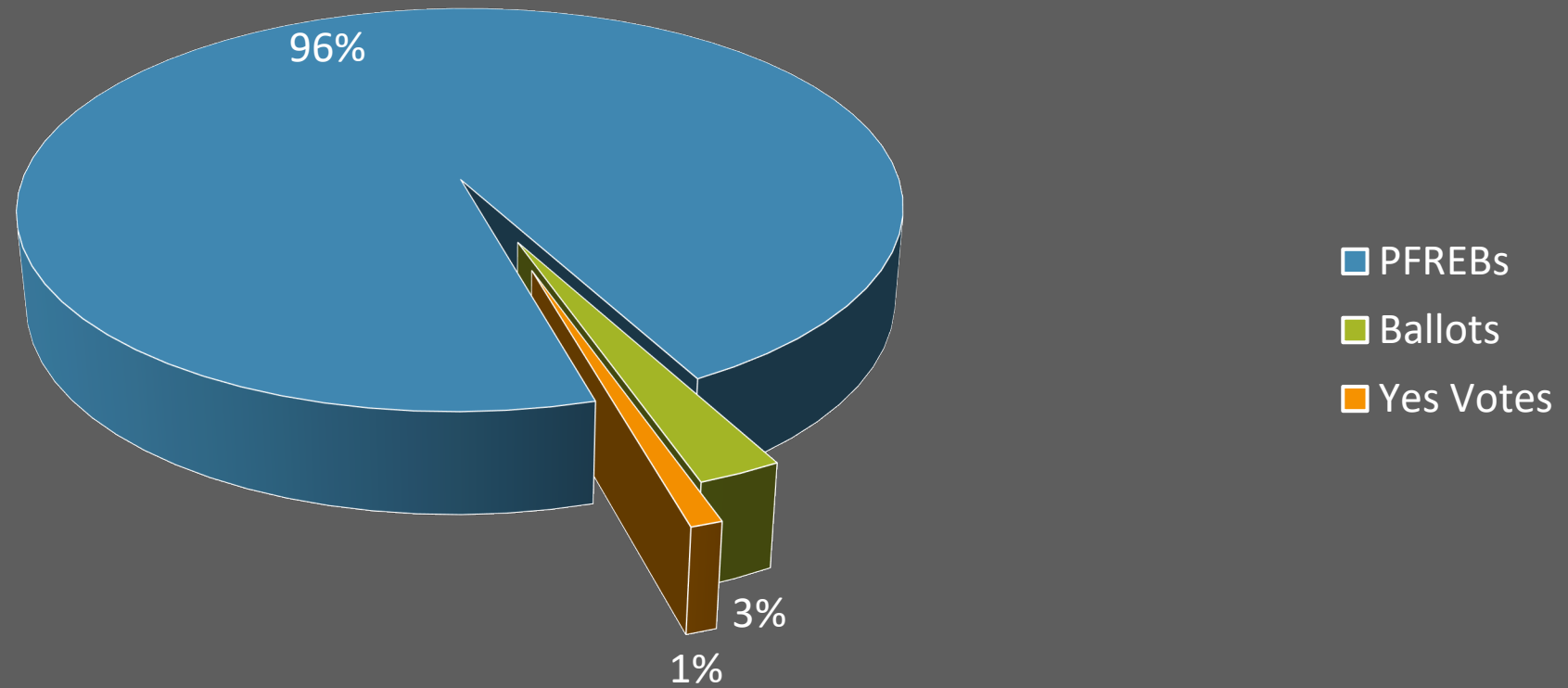

REVERSAL RATE BY CIRCUIT



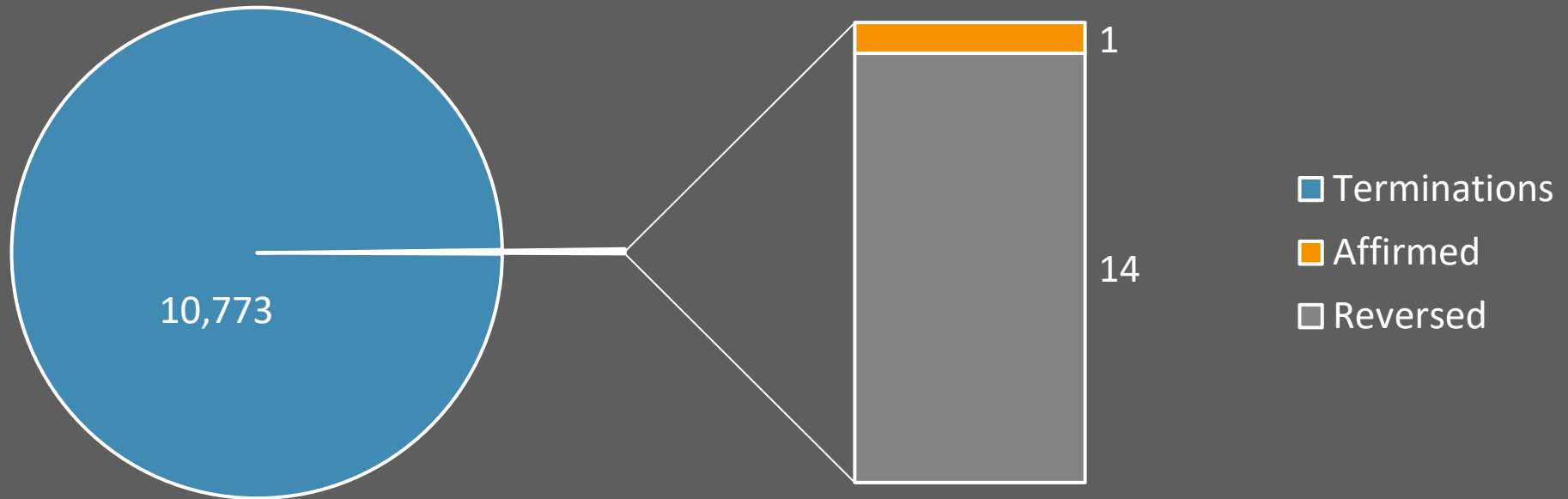
EN BANCS 2020
