Victor M. Gonzalez Vazquez appeals from the district court's order granting in part, and denying in part, his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) motion for a sentence reduction. Pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), Gonzalez Vazquez's counsel has filed a brief stating that there are no grounds for relief,

along with a motion to withdraw as counsel of record. We have provided Gonzalez Vazquez the opportunity to file a pro se supplemental brief. No pro se supplemental brief or answering brief has been filed.

Our independent review of the record pursuant to *Penson v. Ohio*, 488 U.S. 75, 80 (1988), discloses no arguable grounds for relief on direct appeal.

Counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**.
