INSTRUCTIONS for Form 8. Certificate of Compliance for Briefs

- You **must** use Form 8 to certify that your brief complies with the word limits, unless you are self-represented and are using the informal brief form.
- Attach Form 8 to the end of your brief.
- A brief does not require a certificate of compliance if it complies with the court's page limits, unless filing under Circuit Rule 32-2.
- Motions and original proceedings filed in this court do **not** require a certificate of compliance.

How to prepare fill-in forms for filing:

- If you have Adobe Acrobat or another tool that lets you save completed forms:
 1. Complete the form.
 2. Print the completed form to your PDF printer (File > Print > select Adobe PDF or another PDF printer listed in the drop-down list).
- If you do not have Adobe Acrobat or another tool that lets you save completed forms:
 1. Complete the form.
 2. Print the completed form to your printer.
 3. Scan the completed form to a PDF file.
