ORDER

PREGERSON, Circuit Judge¹:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, alleges that a circuit judge, sitting in the district court by designation, improperly revoked his supervised release and did not allow him to represent himself. These charges relate directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).

DISMISSED.
