**ORDER** 

**KOZINSKI**, Chief Judge:

A pro se prisoner alleges that a magistrate judge made various errors in his habeas case. These charges relate directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).

Complainant also alleges that the judge racially discriminated against him.

But adverse rulings aren't proof of bias, and complainant hasn't offered any other evidence of misconduct, so this charge must be dismissed. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 583 F.3d 598, 598 (9th Cir. 2009); see also 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

DISMISSED.
