ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that a district judge improperly dismissed four of his civil cases for lack of jurisdiction, failed to order service of the summons and complaints on defendants, and issued inconsistent orders. These charges relate directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).
