ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that a district judge and three circuit judges made various errors in his civil case. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judges' rulings and must therefore be dismissed. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); <u>In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct</u>, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).

Complainant previously filed a misconduct complaint against a district judge and three circuit judges which was dismissed, and the dismissal was affirmed on review. <u>See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct</u>, Nos. 10-90118+ (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2011). Complainant is cautioned that a "complainant who has filed repetitive, harassing, or frivolous complaints, or has otherwise abused the complaint procedure, may be restricted from filing further complaints." Judicial-Conduct Rule 10(a); <u>see also In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct</u>, 552 F.3d 1146, 1148 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009).
