ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that a district judge and three circuit judges made various errors in his civil case. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judges' rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).

Complainant previously filed a misconduct complaint against a district judge and three circuit judges which was dismissed, and the dismissal was affirmed on review. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, Nos. 10-90118+ (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2011). Complainant is cautioned that a “complainant who has filed repetitive, harassing, or frivolous complaints, or has otherwise abused the complaint procedure, may be restricted from filing further complaints.” Judicial-Conduct Rule 10(a); see also In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 552 F.3d 1146, 1148 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009).
