ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se litigant, alleges that a district judge had no jurisdiction to dismiss his civil case, and that three circuit judges improperly affirmed the ruling. Complainant believes the judges "accepted [the defendants'] misrepresentation and fraud as fact," and thus "became accomplices and accessories to misrepresentation and fraud." These charges relate directly to the merits of the judges' rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).
