ORDER**KOZINSKI**, Chief Judge:

A pro se prisoner alleges that a district judge improperly granted a procedural motion in his habeas case. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judge's ruling and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982).

Complainant also claims that the judge is biased against him. Adverse rulings do not prove bias, and because complainant offers no other evidence to support his bias claim, this charge must be dismissed. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 631 F.3d 961, 963 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2011); 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

DISMISSED.
