ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that a district judge failed to recuse himself in her civil case. This charge relates directly to the merits of the judge's ruling and is therefore dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 623 F.3d 1101, 1102 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2010).

To the extent complainant makes allegations against individuals who are not federal judges, those allegations are dismissed because the misconduct complaint procedure doesn't apply to them. Judicial-Conduct Rule 4.
