ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that a district judge improperly dismissed her civil case. This allegation relates directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Complainant asks that her case be reopened, but even if misconduct had occurred, this form of relief is not available through the misconduct complaint procedure, which complainant acknowledged in writing. See 28 U.S.C. § 354(a)(2); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(a).

DISMISSED.
