KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

Two pro se litigants allege that two circuit judges obstructed justice by denying their motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. Even if complainants had supported these claims with some evidence (which they have not), any disagreement they have with the judges' ruling is merits-related and not cognizable in misconduct proceedings. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).
