ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that two district judges improperly denied her motions to appoint counsel in her civil cases on the basis of a claimed developmental disability. These allegations call into question the correctness of the judges' rulings on the motions, and must be dismissed because they relate directly to the merits of those rulings. See Judicial-Conduct Rule 3(h)(3)(A); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); see also 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Because the complaint doesn't contain any other allegations in support of the misconduct claim, it must be dismissed as unsupported. See Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D); In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 631 F.3d 961, 962–63 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2011); see also 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

DISMISSED.
