ORDER

KOZINSKI, Chief Judge:

A pro se prisoner alleges that a district judge and a magistrate judge made improper rulings in two civil rights cases. Complainant alleges that the district judge failed to appoint counsel, which caused him to miss appellate deadlines, and that the magistrate judge wrongly recommended dismissing his case. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judges' rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

DISMISSED.
