**ORDER**

**KOZINSKI**, Chief Judge:

Complainant filed a judicial misconduct complaint against three circuit judges, but his submission includes only documents from the underlying case and raises no allegations of misconduct. “Under our rules, a judicial misconduct complaint ‘must contain a concise statement that details the specific facts on which the claim of misconduct or disability is based’” and that “set[s] forth the alleged misconduct in a clear and straightforward fashion.” In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 630 F.3d 968, 968–69 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2010) (quoting Judicial-Conduct Rule 6(b)). Because complainant alleges no misconduct, the complaint is dismissed.

**DISMISSED.**
