ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that a magistrate judge improperly denied his mandamus petition. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

To the extent that complainant reiterates allegations made against a district judge in his previous complaint, the former chief judge dismissed those charges and the Judicial Council affirmed. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, No. 12-90134 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2013). Therefore, no further action is necessary. See Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(C); see In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 563 F.3d 853, 854 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009).

DISMISSED.
