ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

A pro se prisoner alleges that a magistrate judge made improper recommendations in two or more of his civil rights cases. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judge’s ruling and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Complainant has previously filed charges against this judge that were dismissed as merits-related. See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, Nos. 13-90105 and 13-90106 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2013). Complainant is cautioned that if he files “repetitive, harassing, or frivolous complaints” or “otherwise abuse[s] the complaint procedure,” he “may be restricted from filing further complaints.” Judicial-Conduct Rule 10(a).

DISMISSED.
