ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that a district judge made improper rulings in his civil case, including denying his motions for remand and certification, and granting a defendant's motion to dismiss. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judge's rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Complainant's request to submit additional pages to his statement of facts is denied because he has not provided a compelling reason for exceeding the five-page limit. See Local Misconduct Rule 6.1(b).

DISMISSED.
