ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that a district judge was biased against him based on his race, colluded with the other party in his civil case to deprive him of his constitutional and civil rights, and committed crimes including taking bribes and personal favors. However, adverse rulings alone are not proof of bias, conspiracy, or bribery, and complainant provides no other objectively verifiable evidence to support these serious allegations. In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 583 F.3d 598 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 2009). These charges must all be dismissed because there is no evidence that any misconduct took place. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

DISMISSED.
