**ORDER**

**THOMAS**, Chief Judge:

A pro se litigant alleges that three district judges committed fraud and conspired to dismiss complainant's civil case, however, adverse rulings do not prove fraud or conspiracy. In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct, 583 F.3d 598 (9th Cir. 2009). Because complainant provides no other objectively verifiable evidence to support these allegations, they are dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

**DISMISSED.**
