ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant, a pro se prisoner, alleges that a district judge and a magistrate judge improperly affixed electronic signatures to orders in complainant's civil cases, or that the judges' signatures are forgeries. Complainant previously filed a judicial misconduct complaint raising the same allegation against a different district judge, and was advised that it "is not improper for a judge to use an electronic signature stamp." See In re Complaint of Judicial Misconduct No. 14-90115. These claims are dismissed because there is no evidence that misconduct occurred. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(D).

DISMISSED.
