ORDER

THOMAS, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that two circuit judges and a district judge “circumvented the law” and issued a decision “devoid of any legal support” in a civil appeal. These allegations relate directly to the merits of the judges’ rulings and must therefore be dismissed. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

Complainant’s request to transfer this judicial misconduct complaint to the judicial council of another circuit is denied because there are no exceptional circumstances related to this matter. See Judicial-Conduct Rule 26.

DISMISSED.
