**ORDER** 

**THOMAS**, Chief Judge:

Complainant alleges that a magistrate judge mishandled complainant's husband's detention hearing by not providing adequate notice of the hearing, and by failing to consider all of the evidence. Any disagreement complainant has with the judge's decisions is merits-related and is not cognizable in misconduct proceedings. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii); In re Charge of Judicial

Misconduct, 685 F.2d 1226, 1227 (9th Cir. Jud. Council 1982); Judicial-Conduct Rule 11(c)(1)(B).

DISMISSED.
