Pursuant to Article V of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a petition for review of the order of the Chief Judge entered on March 21, 2018, dismissing the complaint against four district judges and a magistrate judge of this circuit.
