Pursuant to Article V of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainants have filed a petition for review of the orders of the Chief Judge entered on July 20, 2018, dismissing complaints against a district judge of this circuit.

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in his orders of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the orders of dismissal.

For the reasons stated by the Chief Judge and based upon the controlling authority cited in support thereof, we affirm.
