Pursuant to Article VI of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a petition for review of the order of the Chief Judge entered November 26, 2021, dismissing the complaint against a district judge of this circuit.

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in his order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the order of dismissal. To the extent complainant attempts to bring a complaint of judicial misconduct in his petition for review, complainant is directed to submit any complaints of judicial misconduct pursuant to Rule 6 of the Rules for Judicial Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

For the reasons stated by the Chief Judge and based upon the controlling authority cited in support thereof, we affirm.
